SSR+ Metacognitive Log Sample Template

The metacognitive logs that students keep for SSR+ can be contained in binders, spiral notebooks, composition books, or small examination booklets. The point is for the SSR+ log to be easy for students to maintain and transport. Typically, students record data about reading time and pages completed as well as their observations about their reading behavior. Some like to include a graph that allows them to chart their progress in reading time and pages completed.
